

Weekend Group Trip Chaperone Guide

Thank you for taking the time to serve as a chaperone for your group. You play a vital role in your children's experiences at the Golisano Children's Museum of Naples (C'mon). Make sure you ask your children questions about what they are seeing and learning about – it will enhance their experience.



As a chaperone, you should:

- Stay with your group and keep your group together at all times
- Model how to be respectful of Museum exhibits, staff and other guests
- Participate with children's play and learning
- Focus all of your attention on your assigned children instead of other adults in the group

Behavior Expectations:

- Children should use their "inside voices," meaning no loud talking or shouting.
- Children are expected to walk, not run.
- Children must stay in their groups with their chaperones at all times.
- Children should leave all bags, cell phones, iPods, and game devices on the bus or in the car. There is no space to store these items and the Museum will not be responsible for any items left or stolen.
- Children should only eat or drink in designated areas. No food or drink is permitted in the exhibits.
- Children are not permitted to touch artwork in the Loos Art Gallery (if in place). The oils in the skin can damage one-of-a-kind artwork and artifacts.
